

Colorectal Cancer Screening **Proactive Tracking** and Protection

The government subsidizes free quantitative immunoassay fecal occult blood testing biennially for people aged 45 to 74, and for those aged 40 to 44 with a family history. Eligible people are advised to receive regular screening, and if the screening is abnormal (positive), you should go to the hospital as soon as possible for a colonoscopy.

*If screened positive, colorectal polyps will be found in 1 out of 2 people, **and colorectal cancer will be found in 1 out of 20 people.**

*If screened positive without a colonoscopy, **the mortality rate increases by 64%.**
