

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






When you see

and concerns.

Often these are forgotten in the heat of the moment, only to be remembered later.

We have compiled a list of questions to help you organize the information about your illness you may like to seek from your oncologist.



Diagnosis and Tests

Treatment Options

- ☐ What is your opinion about the best treatment for me?
- ☐ How likely is it that the treatment will improve my symptoms?
- ☐ Is genomic testing an option for me? How is it going to help with my treatment?
- ☐ Can I have children after cancer treatments?

Costs

- ☐ Are cancer treatments covered by National Health Insurance?
- ☐ Are there any drugs not covered by NHI that I can consider? If so, what will be the costs?
- ☐ If I'm worried about managing the expenses of cancer care, who can help me?
- ☐ Can I work while getting treatments?

 Am I eligible for any benefits if I cannot work?
- ☐ Am I eligible for social welfare (disability ID, disability pension, caregiver allowance, etc.)?

Living With Cancer

- ☐ How will the cancer treatment affect my daily activities (diet, exercise, work, sexual drive, etc.)?
- ☐ What foods should I eat to get nutrition during cancer treatment?
- ☐ Is there anything that I can do before or during my treatment to make it more effective (diet, exercise, quite smoking, etc.)?
- ☐ Can I take Chinese medicine or my other medications (such as prescriptions for diabetes)?
- $\hfill\square$ What signs or symptoms should I go to the ER for?
- $\hfill \square$ Is sexual activity OK during cancer treatment?

Support Information

- ☐ Are there services/support groups that can help me and my family deal with this illness?
- ☐ Are there any specific materials that would be useful (pamphlets, books, videos, websites)?
